Sightseeing in Gothenburg



<u>Haga</u>

Haga is one of the oldest neighbourhoods in Gothenburg and well worth a visit. The pedestrian street Haga Nygata is lined with wellpreserved houses, many in the characteristic Gothenburg style.

There are many independent shops and cafes, including one of the best bakeries in Gothenburg, Café Husaren. Haga is conveniently located within walking distance of the city centre, but if you arrive by tram you can get off at the stops Hagakyrkan or Järntorget.

Island walks in the Archipelago

With over 20 islands, the archipelago of Gothenburg is full of seaside gems showcasing small Swedish fishing towns and is a great option for a quieter day out of the city.

The car free islands in the southern archipelago are easily reached with Styrsöbolaget's boats from Saltholmen boat terminal. Take tram 11 or 9 from Centre. Gothia Cup Cards will provide free transport including on the ferry from Sunday 14th to Saturday 21st July.





Visit the Heden Centre

The Heden Centre opens on the Sunday before matches start and with an Information Desk, as well as shops and activities, it is a useful hub to help spectators prepare for the week ahead.

Although this is the "Tournament Centre", you will only see a small number of matches here. However, you are certain to see some fantastic games as many of the showcase matches are held at The Heden Centre, often attracting thousands of spectators.

The Heden Centre bus stop is also where many of the bus routes to the pitches start.





<u>Afternoon Tea & Spa</u>

Enjoy the Afternoon Tea and Spa package at The Riverton which can be booked in advance from £70pp.

The Riverton is also host to the award-winning, View Skybar & Restaurant, which is located on the 12th floor giving fantastic views across Gothenburg.

Space travel, sharks, chemistry experiments, the world's most venomous snakes, rainforest safaris, and adventures among dinosaurs.


At Universeum, everything from unimaginably large galaxies to the tiniest particles of life is explored with exciting exhibitions and fun, interactive activities.

Hop On - Hop Off City Tours


